A language barrier might slow you down a little during your preparation, but it can never stop you from achieving your dream. There's no restriction based on your Tamil background. Create a Study Plan Syllabus - Familiarize yourself with the UPSC syllabus, Cover topics like History, Geography, Polity, Economy, Environment, Science & Tech, and Current Affairs Daily.

Dedicate 6–8 hours daily, balancing static subjects from NCERT books for basics and dynamic topics, must read daily newspapers like The Hindu or Indian Express or TOI. Follow monthly magazines like Vision IAS.

Choose a subject you're comfortable with (e.g., Tamil Literature, History, or Public Administration). Tamil Literature is a popular choice among Tamil students due to familiarity and scoring potential.

Use free online resources like RAM IAS, Unacademy, BYJU'S, or YouTube channels like Sleepy classes IAS, StudyIQ, PW IAS etc,

If you're comfortable with Tamil, you can write the Mains exam in Tamil, but English proficiency is crucial for CSAT and Preliminary question paper also in English and Hindi medium only.

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Begin your preparation in advance. If you're a beginner, focus on building a strong foundation with NCERT, English language and CSAT is the entry door for civil service exam which is qualifying exam but plays a key role to enter the mains examination.

Overcome Challenges Language Barrier : If English is a challenge, dedicate time to improve it through basic grammar books -

WREN & MARTIN - High School English Gram & Comp- this book might help you to improve your English, do read English newspapers daily.

Stay Disciplined and Consistency is key so Avoid distractions and maintain a healthy routine with time for revision and relaxation. Join study groups (online or offline) with other Tamil aspirants for peer support.8. Believe in Yourself, Your background as a Tamil student is not a limitation.
